This report presents an overview of a 5-day research methodology workshop aimed at providing researchers with a deeper understanding of research concepts and approaches, selecting appropriate tools and techniques, and their proficiency in using SPSS for data analysis. The workshop covered a range of topics designed to equip participants with comprehensive knowledge and practical expertise in conducting effective research.

Objectives:

- To enhance understanding fundamental principles of research methodologies and approaches.
- To enable participants to select appropriate tools and techniques for different research scenarios.
- To improve participants' analytical skills in interpreting research data.
- To provide hands-on experience with various research tools, with a particular focus on SPSS.

The workshop was structured across five days, with each day dedicated to specific aspects of research methodology and analytical skills development. The workshop covered various topics, including research design, data collection, data cleaning, statistical analysis, and interpretation of results. The workshop outline included the following:

Day-1st: 8th July, 2023

Session 1: Inaugural Session (2:30 pm to 3.30 pm)

The workshop commenced with the ceremonial lighting of a lamp before Goddess Saraswati and Doctor Harisingh Gour. Prof. J.K Jain, the Workshop Director and Head of the Department of Commerce, warmly welcomed the esteemed guests with garland and offered shrifaal. He then proceeded to address the audience, outlining the workshop's objectives.

The Chief Patron, Prof. Neelima Gupta, the honorable Vice Chancellor, graced the event and extended a warm welcome to the guests on the stage. She shared her thoughts on the importance of conducting research methodology workshops and expressed her concern regarding the declining quality of research. She emphasized that not only scholars in the field of Social Sciences but also those in the field of Science could benefit from this hands-on workshop, particularly through the use of SPSS.

Following her address, Prof. Shurveer Singh Bhanawat, the Resource Person, encouraged the participants to delve into extensive reading to gain a deeper understanding of research. He concluded his speech by wishing the participants a productive stay and expressing his hope that they would return with enriched knowledge of research.

In the concluding moments of the session, Prof. J.K Jain, Head of Department of Commerce and Programme Director along with Dr. Rupali Saini Convener & Coordinator, Dr. Sushama Yadav Co-coordinator and Dr. Anita Kumari Co-coordinator felicitated honorable Vice Chancellor Prof. Neelima Gupta, the Resource Person Prof. Shurveer Singh Bhanawat and Dr. Shilpa Lodha.

Professor J.K. Jain, the Programme Director and Head of the Department of Commerce, expressed gratitude towards all the guests and participants. Dr. Rupali Saini, the Convener & Coordinator, delivered the Vote of Thanks to conclude the event.

Session 2: Framework of Good Academic Research-Theoretical (3:30 pm to 5:30 pm)

The first theoretical session on Framework of Good Academic Research was conducted by Prof. Shruveer Singh Bhanawat, the Resource Person, covered various fundamental aspects of research including how to conduct good academic research, how to select the appropriate sample sizes and sampling method and the importance of research ethics. At the end, He assigned a practical assignment to all participants, dividing them into groups. The assignment involved collecting data from different sector companies over a span of five years. The purpose of this assignment was to provide participants with a hands-on opportunity to apply the statistical tests and concepts they had learned during the workshop.

Day-2nd: 9th July, 2023

Session 1: Measurement Scale and Basic Terminologies used in Research-Theoretical (10:30 am to 1.00 pm)

Prof. S.S Bhanawat, the Resource Person, provided participants with a detailed explanation of several key terminologies used in research. He elaborated on concepts such as Null and Alternative Hypothesis, normal distribution, test of significance, p-value, critical region, and level of significance. He also covered various measurement scales used in data collection including nominal, ordinal, interval, and ratio scales. Participants learned how to determine the appropriate measurement scale for different types of data, enabling them to make informed decisions during their research process.

Session 2: Use of AI tools for Systematic review of literature, Handshake with SPSS and Data cleaning- Practical (2:00 pm to 5.00 pm)

Dr. Shilpa Lodha, the Resource Person, provided a comprehensive briefing to the participants on the importance of conducting a Review of Literature in research. She emphasized the significance of a thorough literature review and shared valuable insights on the process involved. She highlighted the role of AI tools in facilitating extensive literature review and demonstrated their practical application. Dr. Shilpa Lodha also provided detailed explanations on how to identify variables, accompanied by illustrative examples. She emphasized the importance of correctly identifying variables in research to ensure accurate data analysis. Additionally, Dr. Lodha delved into the fundamentals of SPSS, explaining its basic terms and functionalities.

Day-3rd: 10th July, 2023

Session 1: Parametric Tests- Theoretical (10:30 am to 1.00 pm)

Prof. S.S Bhanawat, the Resource Person, introduced participants to the concepts of descriptive and inferential statistics. He provided a comprehensive explanation of the basic concepts of central tendency, including measures such as mean, median, and mode. Moreover, he delved into various statistical tests that are commonly employed in research. He explained the applications

and procedures of tests such as the T-test, Z-test, Chi-Square, and ANOVA, in which situations particular tests would be appropriate, and how to interpret the results obtained from these tests.

Session 2: Hands on Exercise on Parametric Tests- Practical (2:00 pm to 5.00 pm)

Complementing Prof. S.S Bhanawat's theoretical coverage, Dr. Shilpa Lodha took charge of the practical implications. She provided in-depth demonstrations and explanations of various statistical tests, guiding participants through the process of analyzing them in SPSS and interpreting the results. She demonstrated the step-by-step process of conducting these tests within the SPSS software, highlighting the relevant options and functionalities. Throughout the demonstrations, Dr. Lodha emphasized the importance of proper data preparation, including data cleaning and preprocessing, before conducting statistical tests. Moreover, Dr. Lodha guided participants in interpreting the output generated by SPSS after performing the statistical tests. She explained how to interpret statistical significance, effect sizes, confidence intervals, and other key indicators to draw meaningful conclusions from the analysis.

By providing practical demonstrations and explanations, Dr. Lodha equipped participants with the necessary skills to independently apply statistical tests in SPSS. Participants gained a hands-on understanding of how to analyze data, interpret the results accurately, and effectively communicate the findings in their research.

Day-4th: 11th July, 2023

Session 1: Non-Parametric Tests- Theoretical (10:30 am to 1.00 pm)

During the workshop, Prof. S.S Bhanawat, the Resource Person, provided participants with detailed explanations regarding the applications and procedures of non-parametric statistical tests. He elucidated the circumstances in which non-parametric tests are suitable and explained the step-by-step process of conducting these tests. He emphasized the importance of understanding the assumptions and requirements associated with non-parametric tests, as they differ from parametric tests.

Session 2: Hands on Exercise on Non-Parametric Tests- Practical (2:00 pm to 5.00 pm)

During the second session of the workshop, participants had the opportunity to practice non-parametric tests using SPSS, as instructed by Dr. Shilpa Lodha. The focus was on several non-parametric tests, including the Chi-square test, Mann-Whitney U test, Wilcoxon Signed Rank test, Kruskal-Wallis test, and Friedman's ANOVA test. She also explained the considerations for choosing the appropriate non-parametric test based on the nature of the independent variable, whether it is metric or non-metric. Participants learned the criteria for selecting the correct test to ensure accurate and meaningful analysis of their research data.

Day-5th: 12th July, 2023

Session 1: Correlation and Regression- Theoretical (10:30 am to 1.00 pm)

On the final day of the workshop, Prof. S.S Bhanawat provided a comprehensive explanation of correlation and regression analysis to the participants. He covered the different types of correlation and regression, as well as their applications in research. He began by elucidating the concept of correlation, highlighting how it measures the relationship between two variables. He discussed Pearson's correlation coefficient, Spearman's rank correlation coefficient, and Kendall's tau correlation coefficient. Participants gained an understanding of how to interpret correlation coefficients and assess the strength and direction of relationships between variables.

Session 2: Hands on Exercise on Correlation and Regression- Practical (2:00 pm to 5.00 pm)

Dr. Shilpa Lodha explained the purpose and methodology of regression analysis, emphasizing its utility in predicting and modeling relationships between variables. Participants learned about simple linear regression, multiple linear regressions, and logistic regression, depending on the nature of the dependent and independent variables. Throughout the session, she shared practical examples and showcased how correlation and regression analyses are performed using statistical software, such as SPSS. Participants gained hands-on experience in running these analyses and interpreting the results to make informed conclusions.

Session 3: Valedictory (5.30 pm to 6.30)
