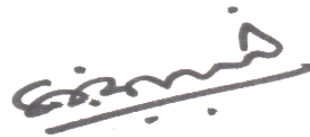

The Minutes of Meeting of Executive Committee of Indian Accounting Association held on 27th February, 2026 at 9:00 p.m. on Online Mode (As per IAA Constitution clause 9(b)) under the Chairmanship of Prof. Gabriel Simon Thattil, President, IAA.

In the meeting, 32 members were present. (List attached as Annexure - I)

At the outset, **Prof. Sanjay Bhayani**, General Secretary, IAA extended a hearty welcome to all the members present online. **Prof. Gabriel Simon Thattil**, President, welcomed all members while making his opening remarks.

Agenda 1: To consider and confirm the Minutes of the Executive Committee Meeting held on 12th October, 2025 at Udaipur.

Minutes of the Meeting of the Executive Committee of IAA held on 12th October, 2025 were approved.

Agenda 2: To consider the Visit Report of the Hon. President regarding the infrastructure and other facilities available at the proposed venue for the 48th All India Accounting Conference to be held at Central University of Haryana, Mahendragarh.

The Hon. President, **Prof. Gabriel Simon Thattil**, presented his visit report on the proposed venue for the 48th All India Accounting Conference at Central **University of Haryana, Mahendragarh**. The visit was undertaken on 9th February 2026 to assess the physical infrastructure and related facilities for hosting the Conference.

During the visit, **Prof. Rajendra Prasad Meena** appraised the Hon. President on the available academic and physical infrastructure facilities at the university campus and its availability for organizing the Conference. The President along with the University team visited the facilities viz: Conference Halls, Guest house, Election Faculties, Conference Office and accommodation available inside and outside the campus for delegates.

The Hon. President also held a meeting with **Prof. Tankeswar Kumar, Vice Chancellor, Central University of Haryana, Mahendragarh** and separate meetings were held with the faculty as well as team members. The Hon. Vice Chancellor assured full cooperation and all necessary institutional support for the successful organization of the Conference.

After detailed deliberations and based on the visit report presented by the Hon. President, the Executive Committee members unanimously resolved to sanction the hosting of the **48th All India Accounting Conference** at the **Central University of Haryana, Mahendragarh**, with **Prof. Rajendra Prasad Meena** serving as the Conference Secretary.

It was further unanimously resolved that in future, resolution of the Executive Committee regarding the venue of the forthcoming conference shall be final and, **no separate inspection of the venue shall be required for this purpose.**

Agenda 3: To decide the norms for selection of Technical Session Chairman and Co-Chairman for the Annual Conference.

The Hon. President placed before the Executive Committee his views regarding the need to develop structured and transparent norms for the selection of Technical Session Chairman and Co-Chairman for the Annual Conference. He emphasized the importance of maintaining academic standards, seniority, subject expertise, and regional representation while making such appointments. He invited Prof G Soral, Past President, who earlier submitted a proposal in this regard to present the same.

Thereafter, several members of the Executive Committee offered their valuable suggestions and recommendations concerning eligibility criteria, academic credentials, prior involvement in the Association's activities, and balanced institutional representation.

The matter was discussed in detail, and after due deliberations, the Executive Committee finalized the norms for the appointment of Technical Session Chairman and Co-Chairman for the Annual Conference.

The Executive Committee unanimously resolved to approve the finalized norms for the selection of Technical Session Chairmen and Co-Chairmen for the Annual Conference.

The approved norms are annexed herewith as **Annexure-II** and shall come into effect from the 48th All India Accounting Conference and International Seminar.

Agenda 4: Any other item with the permission of the Chair.

(1) Renewal of IAA Society Registration

The General Secretary informed the Executive Committee that the Society Registration of the Indian Accounting Association has been successfully renewed for a further period of five years with effect from **11.10.2025**. The Renewal Certificate has been duly received from the Registrar of Societies Office, Varanasi.

The Committee was informed that entire process of renewal was efficiently completed under the guidance and dedicated efforts of **Advocate H. R. Gupta, Lucknow**, in coordination with the office of the General Secretary.

The members placed on record their appreciation for the systematic follow-up and timely completion of statutory formalities, ensuring continuity of the Association's legal status without interruption.

The Executive Committee unanimously resolved to:

1. Take note of the successful renewal of the Society Registration of the Indian Accounting Association for a further period of five years w.e.f. 11.10.2025.

2. Place on record its sincere appreciation and acknowledgement of the dedicated efforts of **Prof. Sanjay Bhayani, General Secretary**, and **Advocate H. R. Gupta, Lucknow**, for completing the renewal process efficiently and in a timely manner.

The resolution was passed unanimously with appreciation.

(2) Registration of IAA under Section 10(AB) of the Income Tax Act

The General Secretary informed the Executive Committee that the Indian Accounting Association has been granted registration under **Section 10(AB) of the Income Tax Act** for the Financial Years **2026–27 to 2030–31**.

The Committee was informed that this significant statutory recognition was achieved under the dynamic leadership and continuous guidance of **Prof. J. K. Jain, Joint Secretary**, along with the dedicated and professional efforts of **CA Priyesh Jain**. The entire process, which extended over more than one year and involved detailed compliance, documentation, and follow-ups, was successfully completed through their sustained efforts.

The General Secretary also placed on record the wholehearted support extended during this period by:

- **Prof. Gabriel Simon Thattil, President**
- **Prof. K. S. Thakur, Immediate Past President**
- **Prof. V Appa Rao, Immediate Past President**
- **Prof. Satyajit Dhar, Treasurer**, who provided timely financial records and documentation as required

The Executive Committee appreciated the collective effort of all Office Bearers, Past Presidents, and Executive Committee Members for their encouragement and cooperation throughout the process.

The Committee noted that this recognition substantially strengthens the institutional foundation of the Association and enhances its credibility for future academic, professional, and statutory engagements.

The Executive Committee unanimously resolved to:

1. Take note of the successful registration of the Indian Accounting Association under Section 10(AB) of the Income Tax Act for the Financial Years 2026–27 to 2030–31.
2. Place on record its sincere appreciation of the leadership and dedicated efforts of **Prof. J. K. Jain, Joint Secretary**, and **CA Priyesh Jain** for successfully completing the complex registration process.
3. Acknowledge with gratitude the support extended by the President, Immediate Past Presidents, Treasurer, Office Bearers, and Executive Committee Members.

The resolution was passed unanimously with appreciation.

(3) IAA Model Curriculum – International Appreciation

The Executive Committee was informed that the **IAA Model Curriculum** was shared at a meeting of the American Accounting Association (International Accounting Section), where distinguished members representing more than twenty countries participated.

It was reported that **Prof. G. Soral** circulated the IAA Model Curriculum for consideration in updating the international accounting curriculum repository of the American Accounting Association. The initiative was well appreciated during the meeting, and the Chairman of the concerned Committee conveyed appreciation for the academic rigor, structure, and contemporary relevance of the curriculum framework developed by IAA.

The Executive Committee noted that such international recognition enhances the academic prestige and global visibility of the Indian Accounting Association and reinforces its commitment to contributing meaningfully to global accounting education standards.

The Committee further recorded that the IAA Model Curriculum was developed under the Chairmanship of **Prof. K. R. Sharma**, with the valuable contributions of the following members:

The Executive Committee unanimously resolved to:

3. Record its appreciation of **Prof. G. Soral** for proactively presenting and circulating the curriculum at the international forum.

The resolution was passed unanimously and recorded with appreciation.

Norms for Selection of Chairmen/Co-Chairmen

All India Accounting Conference and International Seminar of IAA

(Approved in Online EC Meeting of 27/02/2026 Agenda Item No. 3)

1. Constitution of Selection Committee

Every year, President of the Indian Accounting Association shall constitute a Committee for the appointment of Chairmen and Co-Chairmen for various Technical Sessions and Seminar Sessions of the All India Accounting Conference and International Seminar.

2. Invitation of Nominations (15-Days Window)

The General Secretary shall invite nominations from life members of IAA.

The nomination process shall remain open for a period of **15 days** from the date of circulation of the Google Form.

Each eligible member shall nominate eminent academicians from amongst life members of IAA, **one person for Chairman (not below the academic level of a Professor)** and **one person for Co-Chairman (not below the academic level of an Associate Professor)** for the Technical/Seminar Sessions. Retired persons who held respective posts shall be eligible for nomination. Self nomination shall be allowed.

3. Eligibility and Preference Criteria

Preference shall be given to individuals who are actively contributing or have significantly contributed to the academic, professional, and organizational objectives of IAA.

4. Rotation and Restriction Norms

- Any person who has served as **Chairman** in either of the immediately preceding two Conferences shall not be eligible for appointment as Chairman.
- Similarly, any person who has served as **Co-Chairman** in either of the immediately preceding two Conferences shall not be eligible for appointment as Co-Chairman.

This provision ensures wider academic participation and equitable distribution of leadership opportunities.

5. The Immediate Past President shall be appointed as Chairman of either of the sessions of International Seminars on Accounting Education and Research."

6. Panel Formation for Sessions

A panel of **minimum two Chairmen/Co-Chairmen** shall be appointed for each Technical/Seminar Session to facilitate the smooth conduct of concurrent sessions and to ensure fair opportunity for paper presentation to delegates.

Greetings of the day!

With reference to the proposal earlier submitted for the formation of the Buxar Branch of the Indian Accounting Association, I would like to submit that, in view of the geographical distribution of the proposed members, it is proposed to revise the earlier proposal and seek approval for the formation of a South Bihar Branch instead.

To complete the Accounting at Head Office Level, formalise the branch financials and structural statuses for the Indian Accounting Association (IAA), the following report has been prepared based on the Standard Operating Procedure (SOP) approved by the Executive Committee.

Section 1: Non-Compliant Branches (Accounts Not Provided)

The following **9 branches** have failed to submit their accounts to the Head Office for consolidation. Per Para 10 of the SOP, submission and endorsement of accounts are mandatory annual obligations.

However, because these branches enrolled members, their **Share of Life Membership (2023-24) and earlier years** and annual membership shares have been successfully captured by the Head Office bank account and credited to their respective balances.

Financial Breakdown of Non-Reporting Branches:

- **Chennai:** Stood up with a significant **₹76,500** in past Life Membership shares. Combined with ₹17,000 (2024-25) and ₹9,000 (2025-26) membership allocations, its closing balance stands at **₹102,500**. Per the SOP, **₹0 interest** has been provided due to the lack of an opening balance and compliance.
- **Lucknow:** Holds a closing balance of **₹72,800** (composed of ₹55,800 in past Life Membership shares, ₹10,000 for 2024-25, and ₹7,000 for 2025-26).
- **South Haryana:** Holds a closing balance of **₹51,700** (composed of ₹47,700 in Life Membership shares for 2024-25 and ₹4,000 for 2025-26 in combined annual shares).
- **Pune:** Holds a closing balance of **₹23,900** (composed of ₹18,900 in Life Membership shares and ₹5,000 in annual shares of 2024-25 & 2025-26 respectively).
- **Tirupati:** Holds a closing balance of **₹16,500** (composed of ₹4,500 in past Life Membership shares and ₹9,000 & ₹3,000 in annual shares of 2024-25 & 2025-26 respectively).
- **Jorhat:** Holds a closing balance of **₹13,600** (composed of ₹12,600 in past Life Membership shares and ₹1,000 in annual shares of 2024-25).
- **Dibrugarh:** Holds a closing balance of **₹5,700** (composed of ₹2,700 in past Life Membership shares and ₹2,000 & ₹1,000 in annual shares of 2024-25 & 2025-26 respectively).
- **Jammu & Kashmir:** Holds a closing balance of **₹3,900** (composed of ₹900 in past Life Membership shares and ₹3,000 in annual shares of 2024-25).
- **North Maharashtra:** Holds a closing balance of **₹3,700** (composed of ₹2,700 in past Life Membership shares and ₹1,000 in annual shares of 2025-26).

Management Decision Required: As these branches do not have a verified opening balance on 1.4.2025, **no interest has been apportioned** to them this fiscal year. The Executive Committee must decide whether to pay interest on the

share of Life Membership Fees until 31.03.2025 or write back the liability for non-submission of accounts.

Section 2: Past Consolidated Branches

The following **4 branches** have previously submitted accounting but have not transferred their funds to the Head Office as mandated by the SOP.

However, during this fiscal cycle, major adjustments were made to correct local financial positions.

Section 3: The Motihari Branch Anomaly

- **Current Status:** Motihari branch has **never sent its formal accounts** for yearly consolidation.
- **The Inconsistency:** Despite zero historical reporting, they proactively transferred **₹31,029** to the Head Office bank account during the 2025-26 fiscal year.

- **Financial Reconciliation:** Adding their 2025-26 membership fee share of ₹1,000, the Head Office has recorded a total closing balance liability of **₹33,477** in their favour. This includes **₹1,448 in rounded-off interest** generated from their mid-year fund deployment.
- **Directive:** The branch must immediately provide its foundational accounts for the 2025-26 fiscal cycle to officially recognise this balance under the consolidated umbrella.

Section 4: Association of Persons (AOP) Conversion Status

Per Para 11 of the SOP, branches that form an independent Association of Persons (AOP), secure a unique local PAN card, and establish an independent bank account are entitled to receive a full transfer of their routed capital from the Head Office.

The following **4 branches** have finalized their AOP status but **have not yet formally claimed** or drawn down their balances from the Head Office:

- **Karnataka (AOP):** Holds a robust closing balance of **₹127,888.65** (built from an opening liability of ₹85,988.65, plus ₹900 in past Life Membership shares, ₹16,000 for 2024-25, and ₹25,000 for 2025-26).
- **Sagar (AOP):** Holds a closing balance of **₹44,646** (Opening liability of ₹29,646 adjusted with ₹13,000 and ₹2,000 membership shares of 2024-25 & 2025-26 respectively).
- **Kerala (AOP):** Holds a closing balance of **₹36,267** (Opening liability of ₹22,367 augmented by annual membership allocations).
- **Udaipur (AOP):** Holds a closing balance of **₹29,974.33** (Opening ledger balance of ₹267,789.53 was heavily adjusted down after a direct payout of around Rs. 2,50,000 was made at the Branch Level and total life membership share, Rs12,700).
- **We need to issue** formal notices to Karnataka, Sagar, and Kerala to submit their approved General Body resolutions so the Head Office can cleanly transfer their funds and offload these liabilities.

Minutes of the Meeting of IAA Model Curriculum in Accounting Development Committee held on 19th May 2026 at 06.15 PM IST online.

A meeting of the IAA Model Curriculum in Accounting Development Committee was held on 19th May 2026 at 06.15 PM online. The following were present:

1. Professor K R Sharma
2. Professor K Eresi
3. Professor K V Achalapathi
4. Professor G Soral

Professor A K Sana, Member, Professor B Banerjee, Advisor, Professor Udai Lal Paliwal, Advisor, Professor Simon Thatil, President IAA, Professor Sanjay Bhayani, General Secretary IAA could not attend the meeting due to their important preoccupations.

1. Welcome of Members by Chairman:

The meeting started at 06.15 PM IST. At the outset Professor K R Sharma welcomed the members and requested them to participate in the meeting and enrich the deliberations by their valuable contributions to the deliberations on the issues to be taken up at the meeting.

2. Minutes of Last Meeting:

The Minutes of the previous meeting of the Committee held on 13th April 2026 at 06.15 PM IST, which were circulated to the members were approved after incorporating the changes suggested by Professor K Eresi and Professor G Soral.

3. Consideration and follow up of the following decisions taken at the meeting of the Committee held on 17th March 2026 and 13th April, 2026.

Members present at the meetings held on 17th March 2026 and 13th April, 2026, had discussed the implications of some new developments influencing accounting discipline such as digitalisation of accounting, artificial intelligence, etc., and arising from these discussions the issues were further discussed at the meeting in which all the members participated and contributed. Following the discussions the Committee resolved to recommend the following actions and activities to be undertaken by the Indian Accounting Association:

(1) Award to ‘A Best Research in Accounting’ after the award of Ph. D/ D. Lit degree by a University in India’.

After discussing all aspects of the issue, it was resolved by Committee to recommend that the Indian Accounting Association may initiate award to ‘A Best Research in Accounting’ after the award of Ph. D/ D. Lit degree on the same by a University in India’. The award may be given to the Best Research in Accounting after the award of Ph. D/ D. Lit degree on the same by a University in India’. The number of Best Research awarded may be one. The award may be given every year. There need to be no age limit for the awardee. However, the person submitting his research for award should be a member of Indian Accounting Association. Detailed Guidelines for the award may be developed so that the ‘award’ may be initiated. A proposal in this respect may be put before the Executive Committee of the IAA.

(2) Award of ‘Post Doctoral Fellowship to Some Senior Researcher for a Pathbreaking Research on a Contemporary Issue in Accounting’ by the Indian Accounting Association.

Realising that there is a need for promoting and supporting development of path breaking researches on contemporary issues in accounting to spur new knowledge and applications in the accounting discipline, after detailed discussions it was resolved that the Indian Accounting Association may award Post Doctoral Fellowship for undertaking research on an identified issue to a researcher. This shall be a motivation to serious researchers to involve in pathbreaking post-doctoral research in accounting area. The contemporary issue may be identified after discussions with an identified potential researcher by a High-Power Committee of IAA. The Committee may consist of five members (two senior researchers in accounting area among Indian Academics, one senior researcher in accounting area from a foreign university, one member from a National Institute of Accounting and one member from a National Academic Institution) may be constituted. Detailed Guidelines for the award may be developed so that the ‘award’ may be initiated as early as possible. A proposal in this respect may be put before the Executive Committee of IAA.

(3) Establishment of an ‘Indian Accounting Association Accounting Academy’.

Over the last three decades there have been significant developments in accounting discipline having implications for accounting academics. With developments such as digitalisation and Artificial Intelligence the rate of change and growth in the area of knowledge and applications in accounting discipline has become faster. This necessitated that accounting academics keep abreast of these developments to cope up with the change. In view of these developments after detailed discussions the Committee resolved to recommend that an ‘Indian Accounting Association Academy’ may be established by the Indian Accounting Association. The Academy may be tasked to organise workshops, Seminars and Discussion Forums from time to time to keep members updated with the developments in the knowledge and applications in the area. Some senior member academics may be nominated as Director and Co-Director of the Academy. Necessary infrastructure may be developed for the Academy so that the Academy may function properly. An ‘Advisory Committee consisting of five members (two senior researchers in accounting area from among Indian Academics, one senior researcher in accounting area from a foreign university, one member from a National Institute of Accounting and one member from a National Academic Institution) may be constituted. Detailed Guidelines for the award may be developed, so that the ‘award’ may be initiated at an early date. A proposal in this respect may be put before the Executive Committee of IAA.

(4) Organisation of Workshops on ‘Fundamental Concepts and Applications of Artificial Intelligence in Accounting’ for the Members of the Indian Accounting Association.

In view of the urgent need for equipping the members of Indian Accounting Association with the knowledge of Fundamental concepts of Artificial Intelligence and their applications in

Accounting after detailed discussions the Committee resolved to recommend that special workshops should be organised to equip the member academics with the 'Fundamental Concepts and Applications of Artificial Intelligence in Accounting' The workshops shall be organised on financial self-sufficiency basis. Subscription for participating in the workshop shall be charged from the participants at the time of registration. Bank Accounting lead may be provided by the Treasurer of IAA for this purpose. Competent Resource persons to hold workshop sessions on different items/issues/topics to be discussed at each session shall be identified and engaged by the Co-ordinator. The period of workshop may be decided as per the requirement on the topic(s) to be discussed and the availability of the resource persons. Two-hour online sessions with lecture, practice and project may be held every day at convenient time. Certificates may be awarded to the participants.

After consultations and detailed discussions, the Committee resolved to recommend that Dr. Biju T., Professor & Head, Department of Commerce, School of Business Management and Legal Studies, University of Kerala, Thiruvananthapuram, who has agreed to shoulder the responsibility, may be nominated the Coordinator of the Workshops.

(5) Certificate Course in Applications of Artificial Intelligence in Accounting.

It was resolved that a Certificate Course in Applications of Artificial Intelligence in Accounting. A draft Certificate Course in Applications of Artificial Intelligence in Accounting is attached as Appendix II.

5.Date of Next Meeting:

It was resolved that the next meeting of the Committee shall be held on 2nd July 2026 at 0615 PM IST online.

6.Vote of Thanks:

Professor K V Achalpathi moved a hearty Vote of Thanks for the Chairman for conducting the meeting and holding the deliberations on various important issues. He further moved a Vote of Thanks for the members for participating in the deliberations at the meeting and enriching the proceedings by their very useful contributions.

Minutes of Meeting of the Committee to examine Proposal of CA Krishna Gujarathi held online at 9 pm on 12th September, 2026.

Prof G Simon Thattil, President IAA (Ex officio Member) and Prof M L Vadera, Member, could not join the meeting due to preoccupation.

The committee deliberated in detail on the proposal received from CA Krishna Gujarathi and resolved unanimously to recommend as follows:

1. Proposal of CA Krishna Gujarathi to contribute ,on behalf of his firm M/s. Vipin Gujrathi and Associates, Rs 8.5 Lakh to an endowment to establish the two annual awards is welcome and be accepted by IAA.

2. Suggestion of CA Gujrathi for IAA to partially support the endowment so as to ensure an amount of Rs 51,000 for each of the two awards may be accepted.

This will need IAA to contribute some amount out of interest earned on its deposits, to add to the interest earned on Rs 8.50 Lakh contributed by CA Gujrathi so that the total amount becomes $\text{Rs } 51,000 + \text{Rs } 51,000 = \text{Rs } 1,02,000$. Such contribution from IAA funds would be in consonance with objectives of the association. Further, the requirement of Income Tax law to spend sufficient amount of earnings of the association for fulfilling the objectives would also be met to some extent.

3. The titles of the awards shall be " IAA R R Gujrathi Outstanding Accounting Educator Award" (hereafter called Individual Award) and " IAA R R Gujrathi Innovation in Accounting Education Award" (hereafter called

Institutional Award).

4. All nominations for the two awards shall be invited on the email ID of the General Secretary. Notification inviting nominations shall be issued by the General Secretary in the first week of February and last date for receiving nominations shall be 30th June every year.

5. Guidelines for the Individual Award:

5.1 Eligibility:

Any life member of IAA currently working at not below the rank of Associate Professor or equivalent may be nominated for the award. Self nominations are also allowed.

5.2 Award Intent:

The nominee should be at the point in the candidate's career that the nominee's sustained contributions have significantly impacted accounting education or accounting educators.

5.3 Award Selection Criteria:

Nomination should accompany testimony for the following criteria:

- a. Educational innovation,
- b. Excellence in teaching,
- c. Publications related to the award's intent
- d. Research guidance and mentorship to students (at any level - PhD, Master and Undergraduate) or colleagues
- e. Impactful service to the profession and/or academic community (including the candidate's department, school, or university)

Successful nominees should excel across multiple criteria out of the above.

6. Guidelines for the institutional Award:

6.1 Eligibility:

The award shall be open to all educational institutions in India offering graduate and/or postgraduate programs in Accounting or related disciplines.

6.2 Submission Guidelines:

Participating institutions shall be required to submit a comprehensive account of innovative practice(s) implemented in the field of Accounting education at the graduate and/or postgraduate level. The innovation may relate to one or more of the following areas:

a..Curriculum and Pedagogical Innovations

- Redesign of course content, introduction of interdisciplinary or contemporary topics (such as FinTech, ESG, AI), or adoption of experiential models like flipped classrooms, gamification, and simulation-based learning.

b.. Technology-Enhanced Teaching and Assessment

- Integration of accounting software (e.g., Tally, SAP, QuickBooks), use of data analytics tools (e.g., Power BI, Python), deployment of AI-driven platforms, and continuous online assessment strategies.

c.. Research-Integrated and Industry-Linked Education

- Promotion of student-led research, collaborative projects with industry, publication of research blogs or journals, and application of big data or AI techniques in accounting research.

Nominations shall clearly explain the objectives, implementation strategy, and distinctiveness of the innovation. Institutions shall also be required to submit evidence of impact, such as:

a.. Improvement in student placements and employer feedback

- b. Growth in student enrollment or program attractiveness
- c. Results of student satisfaction surveys
- d. Academic performance enhancements

All nominations shall be certified by the Head of the Institution and supported with relevant documentation.

7. IAA office bearers, jury members of the awards and their close relatives (spouse, son, daughter in law, daughter, son-in-law, brother and sister) shall not be eligible to apply for the individual award. Nor the institutions in which they are serving shall be eligible to apply for the institutional award.

8. Any institution or individual getting an award shall not be entitled to apply for the similar award again.

9. Upper age limit to apply for individual award shall be 70 years.

10. A Six-member committee shall be constituted as follows for judgement of both the awards:

- i. Chairman and two senior Members to be nominated from IAA fraternity

- ii. Two Senior Experts to be nominated from outside IAA fraternity

- iii. Prof Mahendra Gujarathi , a renowned academician from USA and maternal uncle of CA Krishna Gujarathi as Non-voting member. Professor Gujarathi may nominate a person in his place in case of his non-availability.

The nomination of the members of the committee shall be decided by the office bearers and ratified by the EC. Term of the nominated members shall be three years.

11. Jury may not declare any award in case no nomination is found suitable.

12. All the conditions of the award shall be reviewed by IAA in consultation with Prof Mahendra Gujarathi (or his nominee) after 10 years.

13. Any other issue related with the awards, on which the above guidelines are silent, shall be resolved by the Executive Committee of IAA.

The meeting ended with a vote of thanks to the chair.
