MINUTES OF ANNUAL GENERAL MEETING

The Annual General Meeting of the Indian Accounting Association was held at the Venue of the 47th All India Accounting Conference at Janardan Rai Nagar Rajasthan Vidyapeeth, Udaipur under the Chairmanship of Prof. K. S. Thakur, President, IAA on the 13th October, 2025, (Monday) at 12:30 pm. In the meeting, 123 members were present (List Attached)

At the outset, Prof. Sanjay Bhayani, General Secretary, IAA extended a hearty welcome to all the members present at the meeting. Prof. K S Thakur, the President, welcomed all members while making his opening remarks.

Agenda 1: Consideration of minutes of AGM held on 24th November, 2024, at Kolkata.

The Minutes of the Meeting of the Annual General Meeting of IAA held on 24th November, 2024 at Kolkata were approved.

Agenda 2: Consideration of the proposal submitted by Prof. Arindam Gupta, Junior Vice President, regarding the conduct of the Annual Conference of IAA.

The proposal of Prof. Arindam Gupta, Junior Vice President, regarding organizing a **three-day Annual Conference** of the Indian Accounting Association was placed before the General Body for consideration.

It was discussed that a three-day schedule would allow all academic and organizational business to be conducted comfortably and without haste. As per the proposed plan:

- **Day 1:** Delegates will arrive at the venue in the morning. Accommodation and food arrangements will commence from lunch onwards. The inaugural session will be held post-lunch, followed by a local tour or plenary session as decided by the Conference Secretary, concluding with a Conference Dinner.
- **Day 2:** The full day will be devoted to academic sessions. The late afternoon and evening will be utilized for election-related activities — nominations, voting, and counting of votes — followed by dinner.
- **Day 3:** The morning will include (i) Branch Secretaries' Meeting, (ii) National Executive Committee Meeting, and (iii) Annual General Meeting, followed by the Valedictory Session and concluding with lunch at 2:00 p.m.

After due deliberation, the proposal for conducting a **three-day Annual Conference** was **considered and approved** by general body.

It was **further resolved** that, in order to improve the academic standards of the conference and to provide maximum time for academic activities, a committee be constituted to suggest measures in this regard as follows:

1. **Prof. Ranjan K. Bal** – Chairman
2. **Prof. Arvind Kumar**– Member
3. **Prof. M. L. Vadera** - Member

The Committee shall submit its recommendations to the Executive Committee for consideration.

Agenda 3: Review the Free Registration Policy for the Annual Conference of the IAA, applicable to IAA Office Bearers, Executive Committee Members, and Past Presidents.

The General Body reviewed the existing policy regarding **free registration for the Annual Conference** applicable to IAA Office Bearers, Executive Committee Members, and Past Presidents.

After due deliberations, the General Body **resolved** that the **Past Presidents** of the Association, who have devoted their valuable time and made significant contributions towards the growth and development of the Association, shall continue to be **exempted from payment of the registration fee** for the Annual Conference as a mark of respect and recognition of their services.

It was **further resolved** that, **from the next Annual Conference onwards**, all **Office Bearers and Executive Committee Members** shall be required to **pay the registration fee** as applicable.
