Call for Papers

Ever since its inception, the IAA has served as an important forum for raising the status of accounting both as a discipline and as an important tool for managerial decision making. The association was founded by academicians and professionals in accounting on March 15, 1969, and was inaugurated on February 14, 1970 by the then Accountant General of Uttar Pradesh at Banaras Hindu University, Varanasi. American accounting Association now has a close relationship with IAA, and offers its membership at substantial concession to life members of Indian Accounting Association. IAA START Guidelines

Step 1: Registration

Eligibility: Participants with high-quality research papers are invited to register with IAA START.

Registration Fee:

Life Members of IAA: ₹200

Non-Life Members: ₹300

Process: Registration should be completed through the designated platform or form provided by IAA START.

Step 2: Publisher Outreach

IAA START will reach out to reputed publishers, journals, and indexed book publishers to invite them to participate in the upcoming colloquium.

A list of these publishers and journals will be shared with registered participants to provide transparency on publishing opportunities.

Step 3: Preliminary-Blind Peer Review

All submitted papers will undergo a preliminary-blind peer review process to ensure academic integrity and quality. IAA START will coordinate the review process and ensure timely communication with authors.

Step 4: Communication of Review Results

Upon completion of the peer review, authors will receive feedback reports detailing strengths and areas for improvement in their papers.

The review results, along with a list of papers including titles, research areas, and other relevant details, will also be shared with the potential publishers.

Step 5: Colloquium Presentation

Selected papers will have the opportunity to be presented at the colloquium. Each participant shall be given 15 minutes for presentation, with an additional 5 minutes for a Q&A session with the audience, including potential publishers.

Publishing Decisions: After presentation the papers may be selected for further process of publication by the editors participating in the colloquium. Decisions on publishing will be made exclusively by the publishers based on their criteria and standards, with no obligation on the part of IAA START.

Step 6: Final Publishing Decision

Authors whose papers are selected by publishers will be contacted directly by the respective journal editors or publishers. The selected publishers and authors will handle contract and publication arrangements independently.

Note:

The Indian Accounting Association (IAA) will facilitate the colloquium via Google Meet; while the registration fee paid for participation in the IAA START process is non-refundable, authors whose papers are not selected are free to submit their work elsewhere, and although START Forum supports and facilitates high-quality research, it does not guarantee publication, as final decisions rest solely with the respective publishers and authors.
